In considering our compliance with our legal and regulatory requirements in 2020, we have taken account of the impact of the Covid-19 pandemic and consequent business, economic and social disruption. We continue to comply fully with the temporary changes to legislation and follow national and local policy requirements e.g. in respect of health and safety, physical distancing, travel, office opening, use of PPE, application of Test and Protect requirements and indoor gatherings.

We are confident that the measures that we have put in place and our business continuity planning has ensured that we are able to continue to meet our responsibilities to our tenants, service users, regulators and funders. Where we have adopted revised standards of service delivery, we have communicated changes clearly to our tenants and are maintaining the necessary records to ensure a smooth resumption of normal service levels when possible.

During the initial three months of lockdown the Board were aware that we did not meet our duties to ensure that all our properties held a valid gas safety certificate due to tenants not providing access as they were shielding or had symptoms of Covid-19. Records of contact with these tenants were kept and as soon as it was possible a gas safety audit was arranged. At the time of signing this statement the Board are assured that all the affected properties have had their gas safety audit completed.

We continue to closely monitor our operational objectives, overall business plan, budget and financial assumptions in the context of the ongoing situation and associated business impact. Our Business Plan reflects the regulatory guidance that was current at the time of its preparation and we will take account of any updated regulatory advice as we monitor and update our Business Plan for the year ahead.

During the assurance process we have noted some areas for improvement. These have been raised and action plans produced. We do not believe that these are material and therefore they do not affect our conclusion set out above.

On behalf of the Board of Cassiltoun Housing Association, I, George Kelly, Chairperson confirm that as of the 28<sup>th</sup> October 2020 the above statement is a true and accurate reflection of the current Assurance and Compliance status of Cassiltoun Housing Association.
